

#### Fares:

Elderly and Persons with Disabilities and Medicare card holders are eligible for  $^{1\!/_2}$  fare when they show a PVTA E&D identification card available at the Information Center.

Elderly & Persons with Disabilities (with PVTA	ID) 50-cents
Regular Cash Fare	\$1.00
Children 6-12 years	75-cents
Children 5 years and under	FREE
Regular and Children's Transfer	25-cents
Elderly & Persons with Disabilities Transfer	10-cents (with PVTA E&D id. card)

Elderly & Persons with Disabilities (\$18/month) • Regular Pass (\$36/month)

#### **PVTA Information Center:**

Services offered include identification cards for elderly, persons with disabilities and Medicare cardholders, bus tokens and monthly passes. The office is located at 1776 Main Street at the Springfield Bus Terminal. Schedule and fare information is available by calling 781-PVTA or 586-5806. PVTA passengers may also purchase their monthly pass at the BIG Y at Hampshire Plaza in Northampton. Elderly & Persons with Disabilities Identification Cards are also available from the Amherst & Northampton Councils on Aging. #### Transfers

PVTA's routes are designed to create a network so that by transferring from one bus to another you can reach your destination. If you are going to transfer, purchase a transfer from the operator at the time you pay your fare. Transfers are good only until the latest time shown, and never for a round-trip or stopover.
